SHIP GENERATED WASTE

Ship generated waste

A new regulation with requirements for handling and traceability of ships' waste in Swedish ports apply from May 1, 2023.






















For waste disposal, a 24-hour notice needs to be given. The ship will receive a slot time for waste disposal. According to the new regulation, the port must assign an inspector to monitor the waste disposal. A receipt with a specification of the received waste will be e-mailed to the ship's agent upon sailing.

Glass, paper, plastic, landfill (complex material), metal, combustible waste and food waste needs to be sorted when left in the Port of Norrköping.

A waste container equipped to receive glass, paper, plastic, landfill (complex material), metal, combustible waste and food waste will be placed directly adjacent to your vessel. The delivery takes place under the supervision of an inspector.

- Landfill (complex material), combustible and food waste should be placed in plastic bags.
- Glass, paper, metal and plastic material should be placed directly in correct box in the container. Due to recycling, it is important that these materials are not placed in plastic bags.

Waste delivery times at Port of Norrköping are weekdays 07.00-20.00 and weekends 07.00-16.00.

Hazardous waste

Also hazardous waste must be notified 24 hours before arrival at the port.

Waste that is not pre-notified or lacks proper labelling will not be accepted.

Additional fee

Extra fees will, as before, be charged for incorrect handling, for example:

- Disposal of waste in the wrong place.
- Disposal of waste with inadequate sorting, labeling or packaging.
